

Article 190: Judged Into Creation

Recently, while engaged in an e-mail discussion of how people “out there” in your world reveal the self and life you are living, we were, in essence, asked:

Okay, I think I understand all that, but how do I create the things in my life? And why are there so many undesirable things in my life? How'd I create those things?

Our answer was, every person and thing in your life is judged into creation to serve you, then when that person/thing acts or changes, you judge your judgment-created person/thing, create a psychoemotional response, and react. All of this can occur in an instant. Knowing this is true, how do you try to serve yourself with your original judgment-created person/thing? What do your psychoemotional responses indicate about the self and life you are creating and living? What does your judging your own judgment-created person/thing reveal about you? What do your judgment-based reactions reveal? By reverse-picturing your judgments, you will see and understand the truth of yourself. [We can use *truth* here because we are looking at the pat of an event where truth exists ...and is clearly revealed.] Now, all of this knowing and much more is always available *in every event*, but you can simplify this by asking, “What does this event reveal about the self and life I am creating and living?” ...and answering this question without judging. Most events reveal that you judge, create, and judge again, ...isn't that enough understanding from one event or circumstance without also laying the occurrence on yourself ...and judging yourself? Instead, with the understanding of the self-created situation, reverse-picture the event and observe your trueself ...then declare that and fully live it as you truly desire.

Events and reverse-picturing just as plainly reveal others “as they are” ...if you are willing to get out of your own judgments to see them clearly revealed, ...but judging events and circumstances ...and the “causes” of things blinds you and conceals all this clear knowing, ...and acting upon your judgments only continues and expands your unknowing.

***It's all right to judge, if you must,
but don't follow that with a second judgment.***

A third judgment creates a habit!

Well, we certainly answered that question clearly, ...wouldn't you say? But the e-mail response was:

My question now is: What does this mean? “Every person or thing in your life is judged into creation to serve you.” “Judged into creation” sounds like I didn't create it, that I judged its existence relative to me, ...is that right? So, I didn't create the traffic or the freeway, I merely judged that there's too many people here, that we're overpopulated, that everyone's in my way, etc. I really want to understand this ...and I think I

do, ...so, did I explain that part ok? I'm going to have more questions about it, but I'll wait 'till you respond to this one.

“Judged into creation” means that you create a thing in your youniverse (the only universe that matters to you), it does not mean that you judge what is in your youniverse ...which was created by another entity. Yes, by living as you do, you create the traffic in your youniverse; ...if you were not living as you do, the traffic would be in others' universe ...but not in yours. If it's in your youniverse, you created it there! ...and since you live by judgments, **you judged it into creation.**

Well, that certainly resolved the traffic problem in her life, ...wouldn't you agree? ...but the next e-mail was:

Whoa, whoa, whoa! This has been a topic in our group which no one can explain, so please tell me how we create everything in our universe. How did I create the traffic? Did I create all the people, the freeway, the cars, and where the people drive? Can I take credit for the Bay Bridge and the toll plaza?

Is there a difference between creating it and judging it into creation? If I wasn't living by judgments, I would still be creating my youniverse, ...yeah?

According to quantum physics, nothing exists in space-time without an observer (consciousness), ...therefore, without your consciousness, the cars and people only exist in your youniverse in possibility (the probability of quantum physics is too problematical, while possibilities are up to you.) for you, yet exist in space-time for other observers ...or consciousnesses. When you bring these possibilities into consciousness, the possibility collapses and they exist with you in space-time. The cars and people didn't just fade into memory, actually, for you, those personthings did not exist in your space-time universe until your consciousness re-created them in your world.

Now, having created these cars and people in your youniverse through consciousness or observation in any form since your consciousness or observation is judgment-based, in this, your action, as the creator from possibility (this is not potential) to space-time, is such that you have “judged these things into creation” in your youniverse, ...then, seeing what you have judged into creation, you judge what you have judged into creation. In the same way, you create the Bay Bridge in your space-time youniverse ...but everyone else also creates the Bay Bridge ...and the people and traffic in their universe ...either as a “possibility or an appearance in space-time”.

If your consciousness or observation is not judgment-based, then you would still be creating your youniverse in space-time ...but not judging it into creation, ...nor would you judge your creations. Do you feel any better now?

Do you see and understand the importance in this? Since all things are of energy ...and energy is either continuous or particle-like, if you desire what you have created in space-time, then you may continue your creation ...or be certain that if it passes back into possibility, whenever you want it, or any other thing, in your space-time universe, it will faithfully reappear ...as other observers or consciousnesses have maintained it, ...or as you created it in the past ...if other observers or consciousnesses have not maintained it, ...OR, if you change from a judgment consciousness, then what you bring back into your space-time youniverse will be re-created without judgment; ...in other words, everything will be the same in every other universe ...and completely different in your youniverse.

Consider the traffic's appearance in space-time as a photon or quanta-packet ...and the possibility as the gap between: where the photon or quanta-packet is, the traffic appears ...and during the gaps, the traffic disappears for you into possibility.
