

## Article 52: Your Subconscious –part 2

How frequently do you say things like, "I understand that *on some level*, but I'm not certain what it means"; I guess, *subconsciously*, I said that, but..."; "That was just an *unconscious* slip of the tongue"; "I do my work unconsciously; ...I even drive with *half-a-mind*, while planning my next job"; "I can talk on the phone, listen to the radio, and discipline the kids while driving ...and still watch for my freeway exit; ...it's the other driver who is dangerous"; "I can do four things at once, because I use my *subconscious* mind." All of these actions are denial of one's actions. In what other ways do you deny yourself ...and your actions by denying your personal awareness.

Do you refer to your denial of awareness an *intuition*? Do you say, "I don't know how I know, ...I just know", ...and call that knowing your intuition? In this you are attempting to relegate this knowing to a *higher self* to *guides* or to *spiritual awareness*, ...are you so unwilling to recognize and accept your own awareness? Or do you believe that others won't believe you unless you anoint your awareness as being greater or finer than normal? Do you understand that by raising this awareness or denying other awarenesses, in either situation, you are denying yourself? In what other ways do you deny yourself? ...or attempt to aggrandize yourself? Are you so unwilling to live your self and life ...and take credit for that? Are you fearful of being judged? By whom?

The power of your subconscious is enormous, ...but that power is yours to actively live at all times. Your subconscious mind never rests ...and neither, actually, do you. Emergent awareness (aka. intuition) is not non-thinking, it is not denying or interfering with yourself, ...it is getting out of your own way, for, as your body clearly and emergently outpictures your self and life, it is obvious that emergent awarenesses have much guidance to offer you, ...or does the truth of yourself frighten you? Is that why you simultaneously exalt and deny your subconscious awarenesses? In what other ways do you simultaneously exalt and deny yourself? Are you willing to release the emergent forces within you to prepare and offer the happiness and wellbeing you desire? This empowering-awareness is the ultimate source of creative power for all things in the universe, ...and this omnipotent empowerment is yours. You see? ...this is not a source to be denied or ignored ...or taken too lightly. And though many professionals believe that the subconscious sees and lives no judgments, while your conscious mind creates and functions only within an environment of judgments, ...where do you suppose the distortions really are?

All that you desire is within you ...and emergently available to you, ...stop denying yourself. Instead of referring to your subconscious, know

that you are **emergent-awarenessing** all you desire into existence. Move beyond your normal judgments of appearances ...and guide yourself to make emergent choices.
