

Article 235: God or Godness? –part 2

Your parents and teachers did not deceive you or mind-blind you ...or impose their faith upon you, they felt that, in your best interest, they were teaching you the “truth” about God and life as it was taught to them. Ohh, they didn’t investigate the truth of their “truths”, ...but then, neither did you. Give us this day our daily bread, forgive us our debts ...as we forgive our debtors, and lead us not into temptation ...but deliver us from evil: for thine is the kingdom ...and the power ...and the glory for ever*, and knowing you are a condition of Godness, you might consider this expanded prayer: **Bringing forth our hallowed condition of Godness gives us our daily bread, forgives our errors as we forgive others, and leads us not into temptation ...but delivers us from errors, ...for our condition of Godness is our kingdom, our power, and our glory for ever.**

You are far greater and other than what your language-created thoughts let you believe ...and believe about yourself and God. You are the condition of your beliefs, thoughts, attitudes, emotions, words, and actions ...you are not conditioned by them. Does your livingself and life express the conditions of Godness you envision? Are you beginning to

understand how these awarenesses enable you to fully take part in a *Godness condition of life* as you truly desire? ...to revel in and enrich yourself in? Is there any other form of life and godness and fulfillment which you desire than this? By judging your self and life ...or others by an individual Godlike-standard, you limit *your own condition of Godness*.

Ohh, by the way, the next time you recite the Serenity Prayer, remember to say: My condition of Godness grants me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change, the courage to change the things I can, and the wisdom to know the difference.
