

Article 279: Your Language God

Would you like to know without any doubt that all is well ...and that you have nothing to fear in life? ...that you live in a truly supportive universe of all goodness? ...that you are on a free will journey of self-realization, enriching fulfillment, and true happiness? Are you willing to move beyond faith and hope and ordinary burdensome beliefs to know and live these things? If so, then you must not try to feel or visualize these matters, for your emotions, being of the present ...without these knowings, will certainly deceive you ...and mislead you. To know these things, you must follow along with your all-knowing mind focused on new language-thoughts which offer more-expansive beliefs and concepts, for only in a mind of new language-thoughts are you free to see and understand these things clearly and knowingly. Mind is the essence of thought ...and language is the form of thought.

However, for untold centuries, teachers and priests have declared that you are unhappy and unfulfilled simply because, instead of living your true-spiritual nature, you are living a false self which deceives and entices you ...and presents you with many different “I’s”, all thinking and acting falsely ...and attempting to *control* matters in life. To resolve this problem ...and your constant struggle, they advise you to be faithful to God and destroy or escape from those may subversive and destructive I’s ...such that you will then be free ...and left with an unobstructed view of your “true spiritual self”. Of course, some teachers even want you to rid yourself of this individualized spiritual self as well, so let’s see if we can simplify matters for you. This problem and solution has nothing whatsoever to do with a false self, an ego or I, or any other self, but it has a great deal to do with *the structure and use of language*.

For example, the sentence *I am spiritual* follows the basic structure of language which declares that something (subject) does/is (verb) something (object), for **I** is the subject, **am** is the passive verb to be, and **spiritual** is the object of your being. Everyday, as you use this language structure to live your self and life ...and for deciding what to do and judging the results, or to consider what happens to you from events or others’ actions, you form your thoughts and your universe and understandings from the idea that you are doing something ...or something is being done to you~you are either the doer or the victim~and as events differ ...and your personal considerations and responses vary, as they always do, you identify differently, *you* are the same, only your identification of self is different ...and these different identifications are not false selves you must

discard. What you need is to choose the **YOU** you desire ...and identify with that for every belief•thought•attitude•emotion•word•action. There are no false or separate I's doing ...or being done unto, just *good old you* making a variety of appearances in the role or drama of your life as you think and write the script in language for you to play. If your language is false, your livingself and life will never be as you truly desire, for as you use the limited structure of language to think and understand ...and to speak and act, out of habit, you immediately lose your empowered self ...and identify with the limited self and life you language into existence.

Instead of constantly struggling with yourself ...or against some ever-varying language-created self, refocus on and affirm your declaredself ...regardless of the roles and restrictions seemingly required of you by language. In other words, know your declaredself and use language as a tool ...instead of your being the tool of your language. Be certain to live your own drama of life, not the role imposed on you by language, for by uniting your declaredself with your true thoughts and dreams, unlimited by language, you will never again feel lonely or abandoned ...or trapped. Stop wasting your life trying to get free ...and begin living your newly discovered freedom from the shackles of language.

Are you beginning to understand how your dichotomylanguage of contradictions and opposing opposites destroys your sense of security ...and heightens your feelings of vulnerability and need for control? How can you possibly find any valuable guidance or true sense of self while living, believing in, and applying a deceiving language for thinking, believing, experiencing, communicating, and acting? Your true nature and real identity are lost in such a language ...which opposes every principle and self you devise to live ...and which destroys all true wisdom.

Your language does not expose judgments and false beliefs, it creates and embraces them ...and expands them. Your language governs and limits your personal empowerment ...and forces you into a life of endless contradictory choices ...which lead nowhere, ...and then forces you to struggle against these deeply embedded habits. Your dichotomylanguage destroys all desirable and reliable frames of reference by putting them into ineffective opposites. Your language create a double standard for everything ...and no standard for anything. Is there any sense of reliability in this language for you? Can you trust such a language? Can there be any self-awareness or desirable emotions in such a language?

...any sense of enriching fulfillment? ...or any happiness or effectiveness?
If not, why ever would you continue your dichotomy language?
