

Article 326: Is the Language of Reason Reasonable? -part 2

This Article will be short because I want to focus on a very particular aspect of the universe and your self and life today for you to understand and reflect upon...and expand to every aspect of your self and life today.

Einstein declared, "What we see depends on the theories we use to interpret our observations", ...of course, Einstein was a realist ...or localist who believe in particular things as relative and relating ...and didn't like quantum theory's action of probability ...which he related to God ...and declared that, "God does not play dice with the universe!"

To Einstein's realist view, the universe exists ...and what you see depends on the theories you use to interpret your observations, but Einstein also developed a broader concept of life and you and the universe which his theories could not explain or unify. For example, according to quantum theory an event happens as a wave, which is a non-event because it is not particularized, then you particularize that non-event wave to a particular event ...and then you see or experience that particular event you have particularized depending on the beliefs and theories you use to interpret your particularization, after which you judge or experience the particular event you have created from a non-event wave according to the judgment-events you have previously experienced, ...then you react or experience the particular event you have created from a non-event wave according to the reaction-events you have previously experienced, ...and then you feel or experience all of this according to the feelings you have previously experienced.

In the last Gathering, I summed this up as: An event•non-event happens (as a wave) which you convert to an experience (collapse wave to a particular), then you judge-experience what you have created as a particular experience and experienced, then you react or experience this strong of self-created experiences ...and feel your reaction-experience of these things as an experience.

Everything from the first particularization of a wave-event to a particular-event is your own creation, thus we can expand and particularize Einstein's original statement of "What we see depends on the theories we use to interpret our observations", to declare that **what you particularize and see, how you interpret your observations, and how you feel about your particularizations depend on the beliefs and theories you use**, ...and your self and life follow this same pattern.

In this, you can see that nothing ever happens to you, for from the first particularization of an event from a non-event wave, you create

(particularize) everything in your body and life ...and experience only what you have particularized ...or created as an experience.

This is quantum mechanics operating in the macrouniverse, in your world, ...do you understand this? ...do you really understand this?
